Event	Description
Ice Cream Social <i>Late August/Early September</i>	This school-wide event for Oak Hill families and staff offers children and parents alike a chance to socialize prior to the start of school.
Back to School Night <i>Early September</i>	Parents are welcomed back to school by staff and invited into their child's classroom to learn about the year ahead. Childcare is provided.
Outdoor Clean-up Day <i>Early Fall</i>	As a community, we come together to maintain our expansive outdoor environment. Childcare is provided.
Oak Hill BookFair <i>A Saturday in November</i>	Held at Barnes and Noble in HarMar Mall, this all day celebration highlights our school through musical performances, student presentations, games and fun. Barnes and Noble donate a percentage of sales on that day, as well as online for a specified period, to Oak Hill Montessori School.
Grandparents & Special Friends Day <i>Wednesday before Thanksgiving</i>	Grandparents and special guests are invited to visit our beautiful school, enjoy student performances and observe children working in their Montessori environment. Refreshments are served.
Winter Solstice <i>Friday before Winter Break</i>	A fun and festive morning for families, staff, and special guests before Winter Break. This is a non-school day as students attend with their family. Refreshments are served.
Spoken Word <i>End of January</i>	Spoken Word is the culmination of the JH January writing interim when students with the assistance of an outside Artist-in-Residence, turn their ideas into spoken word. Their work is highlighted during this evening performance. Childcare is available.
Spring Auction <i>March/April</i>	Mark your calendars for an evening event featuring live and silent auction items provided by families, businesses, and Oak Hill students. Your ticket to this event is already paid for as it is covered by your yearly enrichment fee.
Great Gatherings <i>On-going/Year-Round</i>	These events are hosted and donated by the Oak Hill Community in conjunction with the Spring Auction. All proceeds benefit Oak Hill.
Year-End Appreciation Picnic <i>Late May/Early June</i>	At the end of each school year, we celebrate the accomplishments of our students; show our appreciation to our amazing staff and to each other for our various contributions to the Oak Hill Community. Dinner is provided.
Graduation <i>Year-end</i>	This community event celebrates the 8 th Grade graduating class of Oak Hill Montessori School as they move on to the next chapter, High School.
Acorn Café <i>Thursdays throughout the School Year</i>	As part of the Junior High curriculum, the Acorn Café is a student run micro-economy where students are responsible for planning, shopping, preparing the goods sold, transforming the JH into a café, accounting, customer service and cleaning. Don't forget to send a little extra spending money to school with your child on these days.
Guest Speakers <i>Occasionally</i>	Oak Hill occasionally hosts speakers who offer information about specific parenting topics.
